



Bishop Dwenger SAT/ACT Bootcamp

Dwenger will offer a four week/8 session SAT/ACT class in February/March on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30-7 to help students prepare for the digital SAT as well as the ACT. This class will dive deeper into the changes and practical tools to use on the test. It will cover math topics on Tuesdays with Mrs. McTague and English on Thursdays with Mrs. Brady and will be additional practice to what is offered in our Math and English classes.

The cost is \$175 which includes the latest version of the Digital SAT College Board book. The class will begin on Tuesday February 11 and conclude on Thursday March 6. Please note that the Thursday, 2/27 class will be held on Wednesday, 2/26.

PSAT and Pre-ACT Score Reports Distributed to Underclassmen

Score reports for the PSAT and the PreACT have been distributed to the underclassmen. (Freshmen did not take the Pre-Act.) Please ask to see your student's reports. In addition to reviewing the reports, juniors have been given instructions for creating online accounts with both the SAT (College Board) and ACT. They will use these accounts throughout the rest of their high school careers to register for exams and view scores.

It is highly recommended that juniors take at least one administration of both the SAT and ACT by the end of July. All juniors will take the SAT at Bishop Dwenger on Thursday, March 13. There is no fee for this administration of the SAT, and students do not need to register beforehand.

Students are encouraged to register for one administration of the ACT on their own. The ACT is offered at various high schools on the Saturdays listed below. The April ACT will be offered at Snider High School, so this would be a good time to test. Juniors are also welcome to take an additional SAT on their own. Test dates and registration deadlines are listed below. If you have any questions or need assistance, please contact your student's school counselor.

Scheduling Materials Distributed to Underclassmen All students in grades 9-11 will receive their class scheduling materials for the 2025-26 school year by January 31. Please take the time to review the materials with your student(s) to help them select classes for next year. Course selection sheets are due by Friday, February 7 for freshmen and sophomores, and Friday February 14 for juniors. School counselors will meet individually with each student to finalize schedules. The deadline to make any schedule changes is Friday, May 23, 2025. Please contact your student's school counselor if you have any questions.

FAFSA - Financial Aid for College-Bound Seniors

Every year, a lot of financial aid goes unclaimed because families think they will not qualify to receive need-based aid. Therefore, the Indiana Department of Education is asking the families of all graduating seniors in the class of 2025 to complete the 2025-26 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Need-based financial aid includes loans, grants, and work-based study. The official filing window for the 2025-26 FAFSA in now open, and it closes on April 15, 2025. (Please note that colleges may have earlier deadlines. Do your research.) FAFSA is submitted online and is available here. FAFSA requires parent and student tax information from 2023.

To complete a 2025-26 FAFSA, you will need a student and a parent FSA ID, one for each. (If the parent already has an FSA ID from filing the FAFSA for an older sibling, that FSA ID may be used.) Create these **here**. Watch **this video** to Create your FSA IDs. Once you have your FSA IDs you are ready to complete the **FAFSA**. It is recommended you complete your FAFSA as early as possible, so your student can receive full financial aid consideration and receive award letters from colleges in a timely manner. The 2025-26 FAFSA is designed to be shorter and more user-friendly than in previous years. However, some families may still need assistance with completing it. Below are local FAFSA completion events available to offer support.

FAFSA Completion and Financial Aid Event for Senior Families

All students in the class of 2025 are asked to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2025-26 school year. To assist with this process, the BDHS Guidance Department is hosting a FAFSA Completion and Financial Aid event for senior families on **Monday**, **February 10 at 6:00 in the library**. Parents will need to bring a laptop computer with them and have their FSA IDs (FAFSA login) created. Parents and students each have a portion of FAFSA to complete, so at least one parent and the student will need an FSA ID. **Click here** to create your FSA IDs. It takes several days for the FSA IDs to be processed, so do this as soon as possible.

BDHS Scholarships

Bishop Dwenger High School is pleased to offer many need-based scholarships, the majority of which are endowed through the generous donations of alumni, parents, and friends. These scholarships are not to be confused with School Choice, which is the program administered by the State of Indiana (commonly referred to as "voucher program").

If your student will be a sophomore, junior, or senior for the 2025-2026 school year and is interested in applying for a scholarship from Bishop Dwenger High School, he/she must complete the following:

Students currently in grades 9-11: please complete, on your own, the **Current Student Scholarship Application** and submit by April 15, 2025.

Students currently in grade 8 (incoming freshmen) or transferring from another school: please complete, on your own, the **Incoming Student Scholarship Application** and submit by April 15, 2025.

Parents: complete the **FACTS** assessment form and submit by April 15, 2025.

Please note that if you have not yet filed your 2024 tax return, you can still begin the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment and upload your tax return once it's complete.

Both the student scholarship application form and the FACTS form must be completed annually, even if your student currently has a scholarship that is renewable.
